General rule

duties only vis-à-vis company vis-à-vis $3^{\rm rd}$ parties: non-contractual liability

Liability of D&O: gatekeepers for misconduct of the corporation









Personal Liability for Damage to **Third Parties**

Requirements for liability

- tortious liability
- pure economic interests
 - general obligation owed by everyone (common law)
 - insufficient assets
 - acting outside capacity as an organ
 - violation of duties with specific purposes
